Inspectors acting on behalf of Green Tourism praised the “number of excellent green initiatives in place” at Stonehouse Court, as well as singling out the “procurement choices” and “waste minimalisation” efforts of the business. To date, the hotel has committed to installing new energy-efficient boilers, using 95% LED lighting throughout the building, implementing efficient recycling and waste minimization schemes, as well as a flagship on-site bottling system for their water needs. A range of local

produce is both stocked in the bar and served via the restaurant, with the management looking to increase the proportion of regional items on each menu.
